Parish Church of San Giovanni Battista

Located in the central square it is built on a Greek cross plan and it dates back around 1447, when it was only a small oratory situated inside the castle of Vicchio. Numerous renovation works and enlargements were brought on over the centuries, the last of which was due to the tragic earthquake happened in 1919 when most of the town was destroyed and many works of art were lost. Today, inside the church, are held important works such as *Madonna and Child Enthroned between S. John the Baptist and Sebastian,* ascribed to Fra Bartolomeo's school, and *Our Lady of the Rosary* of Alessandro Fei.
